Each year, Essendon North Primary School arranges a variety of learning and teaching experiences. Some of these experiences throughout the year are organised as local excursions, which require walking around the school area. At Essendon North Primary School, a local walking excursion is defined by a radius no greater than 2.5km from the school.
